

YHA MEN'S MASTERS CUP 2019-20 PLAYER ELIGIBILITY



CLUB:

1. On the date of any match in the 2019/20 YHA Men's Masters Cup (the "Competition"), a player must be eligible to play for that club in an outdoor weekend league match, and if the match is after 28 February 2020, a player must have been eligible to play for that club in an outdoor weekend league match prior to 28 February 2020 in that season.
2. Players who have previously played for another club in an outdoor weekend league match during the same season shall only be eligible under Regulation 1 if they have genuinely changed clubs during this period and severed all links with their previous club.

(Note: An outdoor weekend league match is defined as any outdoor open-age match in an organised league where the matches are regularly played on a Saturday or Sunday (e.g. England, North or Yorkshire hockey leagues or equivalent).)

3. A player cannot play for more than 1 club in the Competition.
4. Regulation 1 shall apply except that a club may play a maximum of 2 players (3 if one of these is a fully kitted Goalkeeper) throughout the duration of the Competition who are eligible to play outdoor weekend league hockey for another club, provided that the player complies with all of the following:
 - The club for whom they are eligible to play outdoor weekend league hockey has not entered the Competition;
 - The player has not played for another club in the Competition;
 - The 2 players (3, if one of these is a Goalkeeper) must be the same players throughout the Competition.

AGE:

5. Players must reach the age of 40, or be older, by 31 December 2020 to be eligible to participate in the Competition.
6. Regulation 5 shall apply except that a club may play (i.e. on the pitch at any one time) a maximum of 2 players who are aged 35 or older on 1 September 2019.

In the event of any disputes, the decision of the Competition Organiser will be final.
