- Teams must be on the pitch and ready to start at the advertised time.
- All matches are 25-minutes one-way
- Umpires are being supplied by YHUA
- All matches will be under the control of a Match Official
- Eligibility: All players must be under 19 on 1/9/2010, plus up to two players U21 on 1/9/2010. U21 players must not have been starred in a club's 1st XI who play in regional or national league. All players must be registered playing members of the club for season 2010-2011.
- All teams must supply an accurate Team List to the TD on arrival.
- Teams are allowed a maximum of 16 players, plus a manager, coach and physio. Teams may in addition include a medically-qualified doctor who can sit on the bench. All players and officials must be named on Team Lists at the start of the day. Coaches will be allowed to stand at the pitch side but must keep out of the way of umpires. Substitutes and other team officials must sit on the bench unless warming up
- The winner will be the team at the top of the round-robin table after all matches have been played.
- Final ranking will be decided by:
 - 1 Points
 - 2 Goals Difference
 - 3 Goal For
 - 4 Score between the teams
 - 5 Penalty Stroke Barrage: Bank of 5 penalty strokes each with the team scoring the most winning but if level after five strokes the result will be decided on sudden-death penalty strokes. Any PS Competition will be carried out on Pitch 2 (top pitch).
- First-named team to supply suitable match balls
- Colour Clashes: University of Leeds have agreed to play all their matches in white. Other kit changes needed are shown above. Sheffield Hallam to play in white socks for their last two matches (this saves Wakefield having to change socks as Hallam will already be in white socks from their previous match).
- All shirts must bear a number as per the Rules of Hockey. Players without numbers will not be permitted to play.
- Goalkeepers must wear a suitable shirt covering any protective equipment and the shirt colour must be different from that of both teams. Please check that your goalkeepers possess suitably coloured shirts for each match.
- Refreshments will be provided by YHA after each team's last game. Please advise by the Wednesday 11 May if you do not want food. Final numbers can be confirmed on the day. Teams not partaking of their refreshments will be sent a bill
- In the event of any dispute the Tournament Director's decision will be final.
